





INTRODUCTION

The Summer Qurʾān Intensive program is being offered to students that have excelled in their Qurʾān studies over the last year. This is an invite-only program to immerse the student with the learning of Qurʾān recitation and memorization through a five-week period, insha Allah.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES



STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Students must be invited/accepted in the program by the director of the Qurʾān program. All students must have an intermediate level of Qurʾān reading ability and have been able to sit in after-school classes for at least a semester. The program is for male and female students, children and adults.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE & LOCATION

Classes will be held in the Qur'ān classroom at 706 Mabry Hood Rd, Knoxville, TN.

Classes will be five days a week, Monday to Friday on the following weeks:

QUR'ĀN MEMORIZATION METHOD & EXPECTATIONS

First Period

Students will recite their newly memorized lessons first thing in the morning, and will be encouraged to memorize and recite as much as possible in this period. Students will additionally recite all previous lessons up to half-a-*juz* of the current *juz* their *sabaq* is upon.

Second Period

Students will then recite half-a-*juz* of previous *ajza* memorized, cycling through their *manzil* multiple times throughout the program's five-weeks.

Students will be required to read the next day's *sabaq* with *Tajwīd* and receive guidance on the best way to memorize their new *sabaq*.

Third Period

In the five-week program, students will learn or re-learn all the general *Tajwīd* rules (*Tajwīd* level 1 and level 2) to ensure they are applying it in their Qur'ān recitation and memorization.

Home Assignment

Have the children **enjoy** the rest of the day and ensure children are engaged in outdoor activities as much as possible. Limit electronic media devices to 30-minutes, or maximum of 60-minutes a day. This will directly affect their memorization progress.

We expect students will spend half to one hour every evening memorizing new lessons in preparation for the first period the next morning.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

The deadline for submitting the application is **May 31st, 2018**. The application fee is **\$25 per applicant/student** and must be paid in full with the application form. Please make checks payable to “Tayseer”.

The program is limited-capacity. In the case we have more students than we can allow, preference will be given to those who submit their completed application and pay their application fee first.

The completed applications and check/cash must be submitted the Qur’ān program director or administrator. There are no online platforms for the application in this program.

Students **cannot** be admitted into the program without submitting an application. All students must have their applications filled out by their parents or guardian (if student is under 18 years of age). Applicants will be notified via email of acceptance in the program soon after the applications have been submitted.

TUITION

Complete tuition must be paid before the first day of class on June 18, or at least the two installments (May 7 and June 7).

ABOUT HAFIZ NOMAN ZAHEER

Hafiz Noman moved to Houston, Texas in 1995 where he completed his education in aviation maintenance at Westwood College of Aviation and began working in commercial aviation maintenance while serving in the Houston community in various capacities as an Imām, youth mentor and institutionalizing a Qurʾān recitation/memorization program.

In 2002, Hafiz Noman relocated to Knoxville, Tennessee where he continued working in commercial aviation maintenance, completing his aviation career as a Supervisor in aircraft maintenance workflow management in 2013. During these years, Hafiz Noman has been leading the Muslim Community of Knoxville in various capacities as an Imām, khaṭīb, youth coordinator, community board member, Islamic school teacher, retreat and events director, Ibn Masʿūd Qurʾān school director, and more.

In 2009, Hafiz Noman completed the recitation of the Qurʾān applying the seven modes of recitation according to Imām Shāṭibiyy (may Allah bestow His mercy upon him) and received his *ijāzah* in *qiraʾāt* by his teacher Mufti Umer Ismail.

Thereafter, Hafiz Noman found Shaykh Mohammed Amin Kholwadia and furthered his pursuit for more knowledge. He has been appointed the Program Developer and Instructor for the Islamic Essentials online (darulqasim.org/essentials) and High School programs while also working as the Registrar for the institution. Additionally, Hafiz Noman has studied the Shaykh al-Hind program and various intermediate program coursework at Darul Qasim. Currently Hafiz Noman is reviewing and furthering his *qiraʾāt* studies with Mawlana Arif Kamal, head of the Qurʾān recitation program at Darul Qasim, and studying other Islamic sciences with various scholars.

Currently, Hafiz Noman resides in Knoxville with his wife and two energetic boys who engage him in tackle football apart from biking, hiking, and watching college football during their leisure.

ABOUT HAFIZAH NADA IBRAHIM

Dr. Nada Ibrahim joined the Muslim Community of Knoxville in 2015. She has a BSc in dentistry from Ain Shams university, Egypt. In 2012, she joined the Oral Biology Department in the same university as a teacher assistant and as a master's student.

In 2005, Dr. Nada began her journey with Qurʾān memorization and Tajwīd learning in Makkah, Saudi Arabia and continued in Cairo, where she received a certificate from *ijāzah*-holding teachers to teach Qurʾān in Egypt in 2011.

In 2017, hafizah Nada completed her Qurʾān memorization while in Knoxville.

She had taught many Islamic courses in Saudi Arabia such as Tajwīd and Tafsīr. Hafizah Nada is also actively studying 'Aqīdah, Hadith and other Islamic studies.
